GET INTO READING

Get into reading groups meet every week in a wide range of venues, during each session a short story or installment of a novel is read aloud by a trained facilitator who pauses at key moments and starts a very informal discussion. Group members get to know each other through the text and get to talk about life's big issues, without focusing too much on individual problems. There's no pressure to join in, people can just sit back and get lost in the story if they want to – and a previous interest in reading is unnecessary.
