JOB DESCRIPTION

Role purpose:

Due to the current pandemic and economic climate, Primary Care Wirral and Wirral Council are looking for people to assist us with temporary volunteering roles.

This is a rewarding opportunity and we welcome applications from those who would like to assist us with the marshalling of the COVID-19 mass testing sites and the COVID-19 vaccination sites across the Wirral.

Main Duties:

We are looking to recruit volunteers to enable these sites to be seamless, ensure that the residents of the Wirral's experience are pleasant and managed in a professional way.

Duties include:

- Managing the flow of patients into and out of the site
- Liaise with medical and non-medical staff on site with patient flow & management
- Traffic Management
- Ensure that social distancing is undertaken

(no involvement in actual testing)

YOU can play an essential role in maximising our capacity as a borough to fight this outbreak both on a local and national level.

Additional Information

- Full Training available
- Full Personal Protective Equipment will be supplied in line with NHS standards. Applicant to provide own safety boots as a minimum.
- Ability to physically stand for several hours
- Willingness to work outside (weather protection will be provided)
- Hours of work to cover a working pattern over 7 days a week with rest breaks.
- First Aid Support and facilities onsite

As we work with a wide variety of people, including individuals who may be more vulnerable than you, applicants must be in general good health and not classified as in any of the COVID High risk groups therefore:

- Must not have a long-term health condition which would put you in the high-risk category
- Must not be pregnant.
- Must not have a weakened immune system through medical conditions or therapy.

Hours: 5-hour shift pattern with option for longer hours
